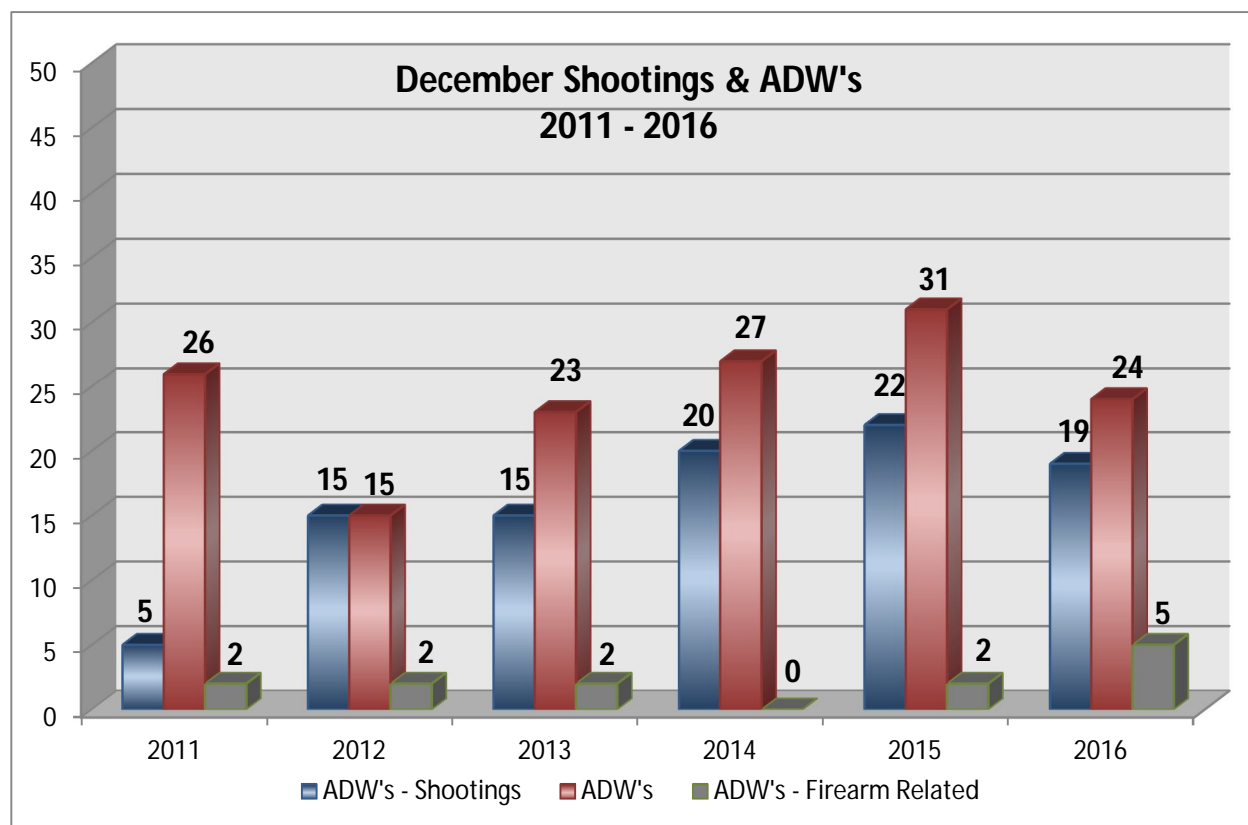

SUBJECT: December 2016 Analysis of Shootings & Assault with Deadly Weapons Cases

Per your request, an analysis was conducted for the month of December 2016 showing the number of shootings and assault with deadly weapons cases.

Below is a chart and table depicting shootings and assault with deadly weapon cases for the month of December for the last six years.



Note: "Shootings" include the following crimes involving the use of a firearm: attempted murder, assault w/deadly weapon, shooting into an inhabited dwelling, and shooting into an inhabited vehicle.

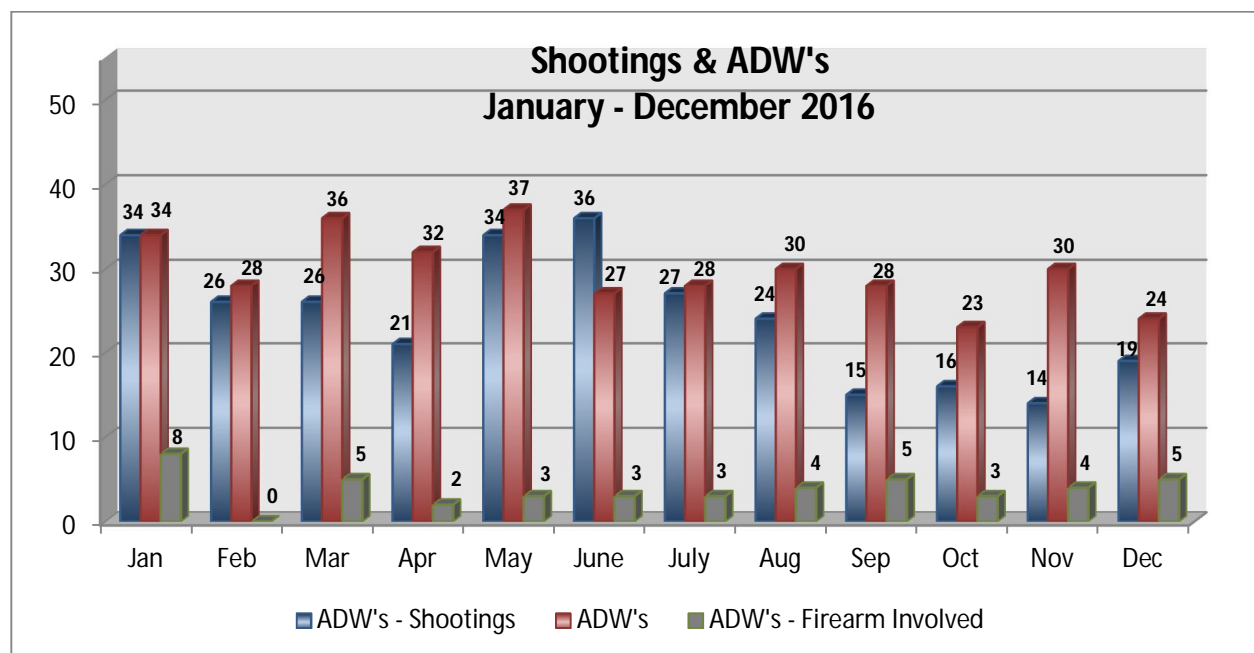
"ADW's" include assault w/deadly weapon not firearm-related (e.g., knife, bat, pipe, etc.).

The graph below shows the number of shootings and ADW’s year to date.



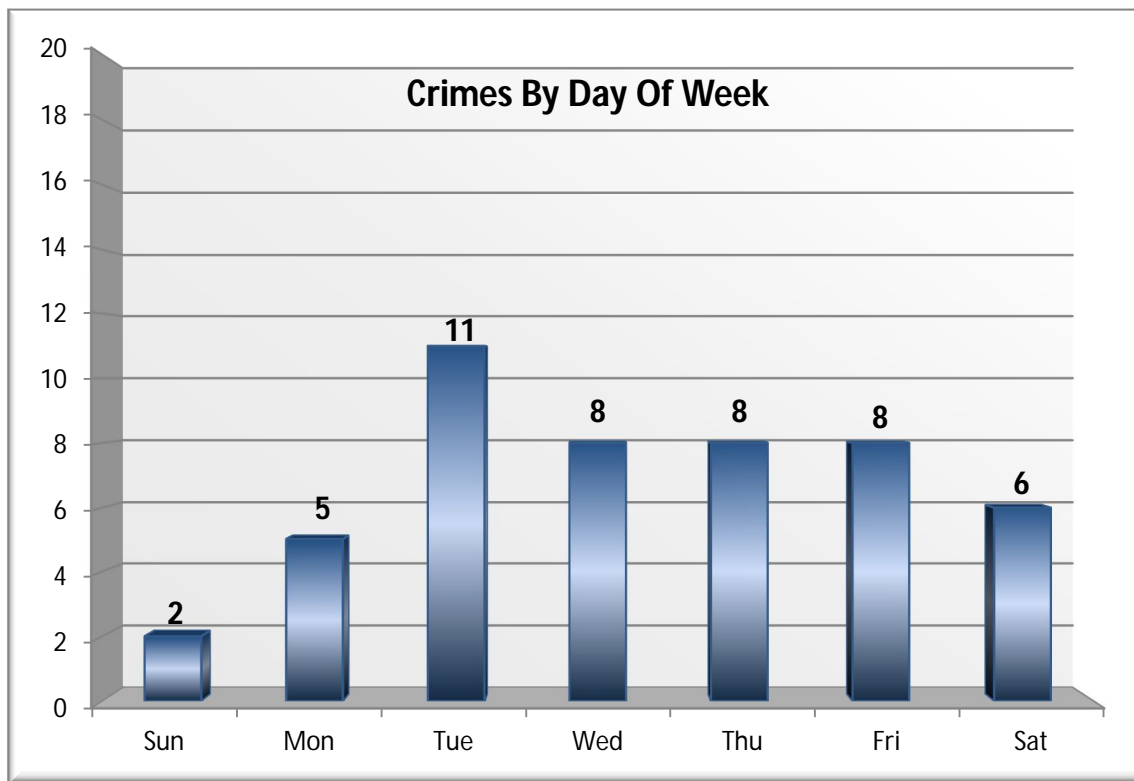

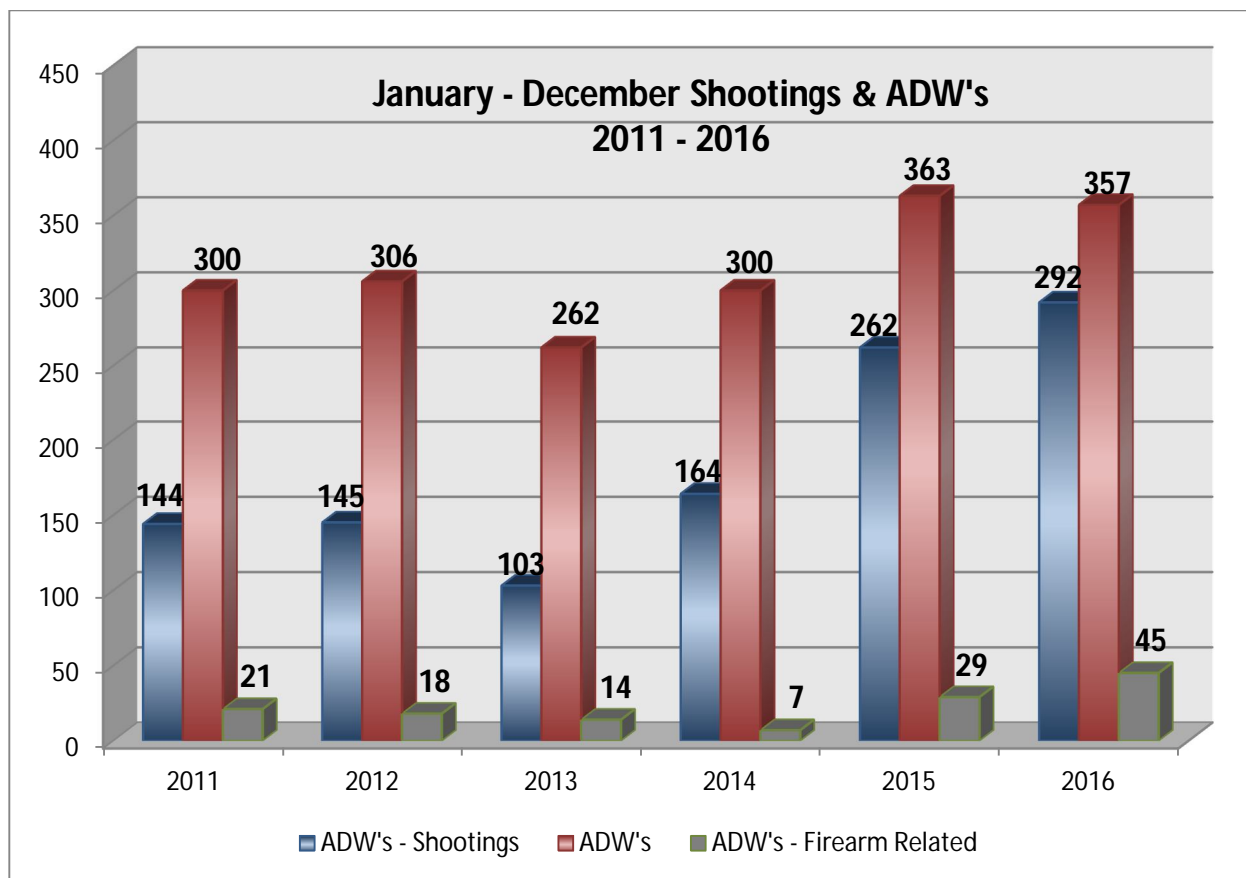

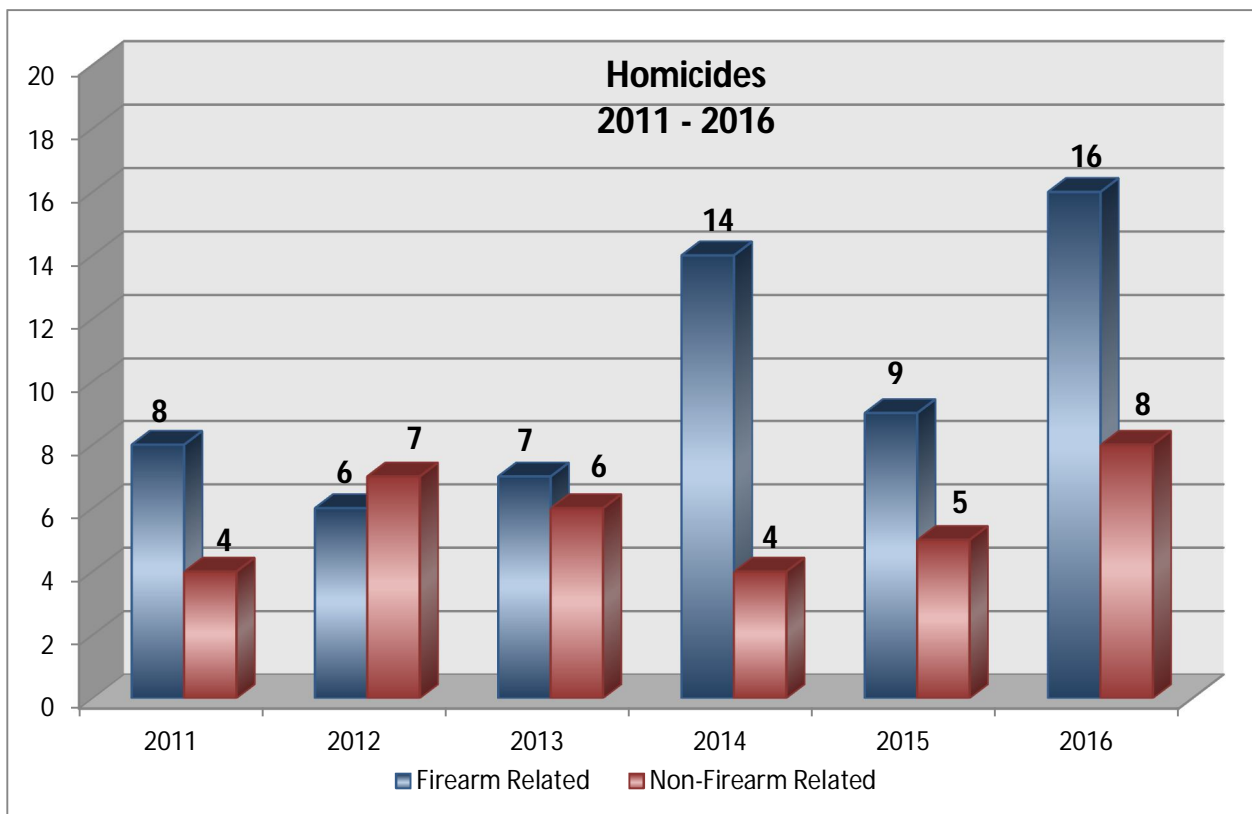
